Management Target: Habitat improvement actions implemented on 20% of identified priority areas of stream, floodplain, wetland and riparian areas by 2016.

## Work Undertaken

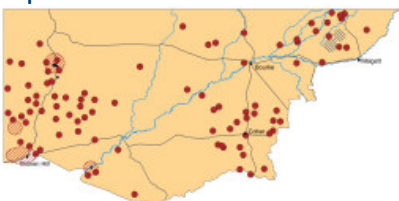
Michael Anderson and Jutta Sapotnik-Eckford of Mogila Station, between Lightning Ridge and St George will fence 15km of the Bokhara and Ballondool Rivers. Three alternative watering points for stock will be installed.

## Benefits

- 20,000 ha of the property will be fenced off
- River corridors can be managed separately
- Improving water quality
- Encouraging native vegetation
- Reducing soil erosion
- Reducing silting of the river
- Improving the breeding grounds for native fish
