

# riverine habitat improvement

Management Target: Habitat improvement actions implemented on 20% of identified priority areas of stream, floodplain, wetland and riparian areas by 2016.

## Work Undertaken

John Wheaton of Boorooma Station, near Walgett will fence 7km of the Barwon River and install four watering points.

## Benefits

- Controlling stock movements
- Helping native groundcover
- Reducing erosion and silting
- Improving water quality
- Controlling Noogoora Burr which:
  - reduces fleece and damage and
  - can significantly increase wool value
